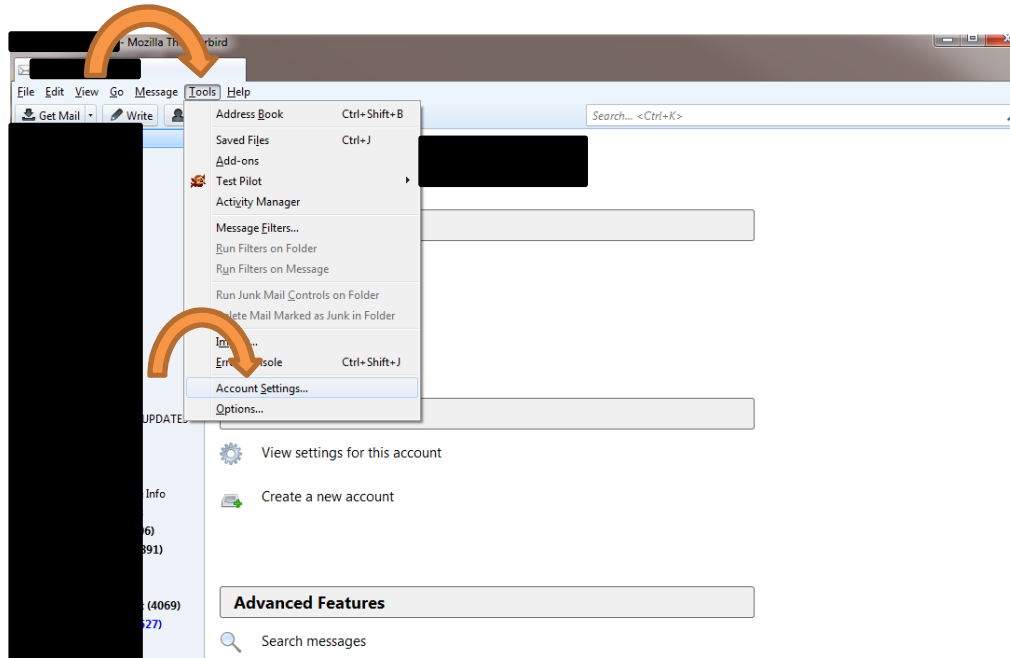


Thunderbird Email Set Up

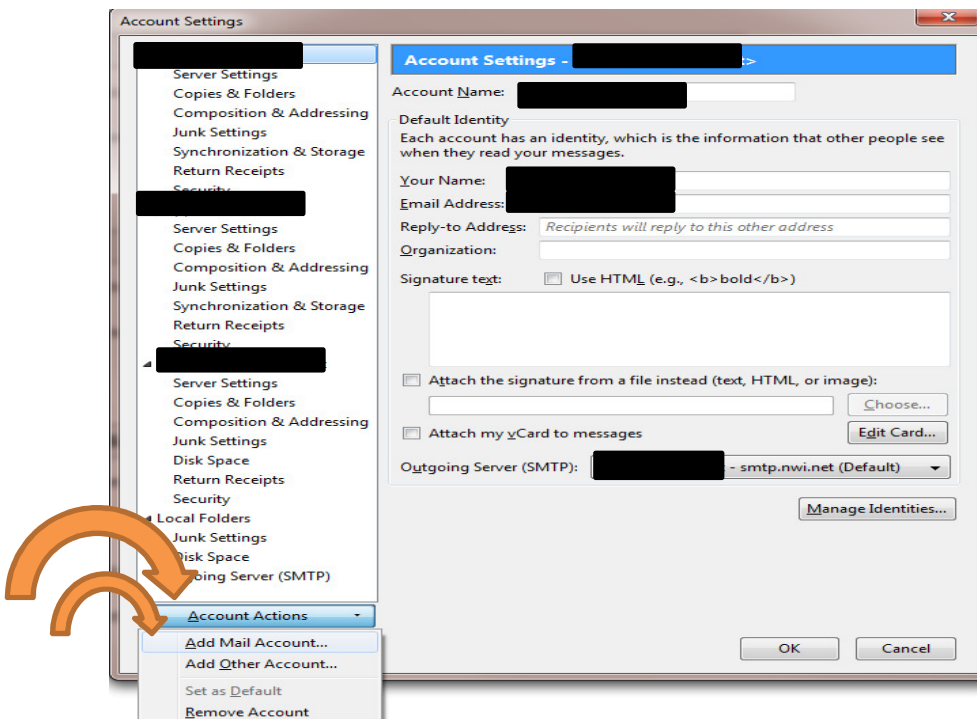
Click on the Tools tab

Click Account Settings

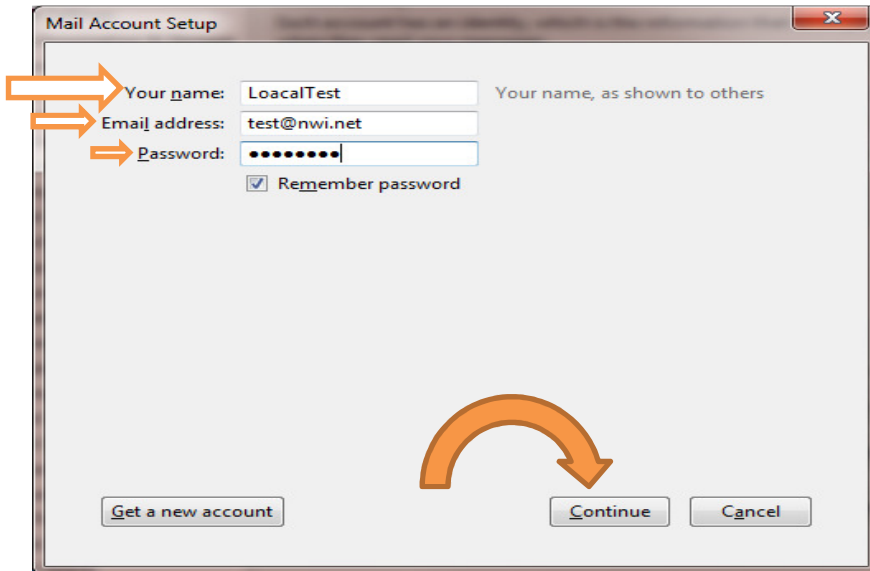


Click the Account Actions menu on the bottom of page

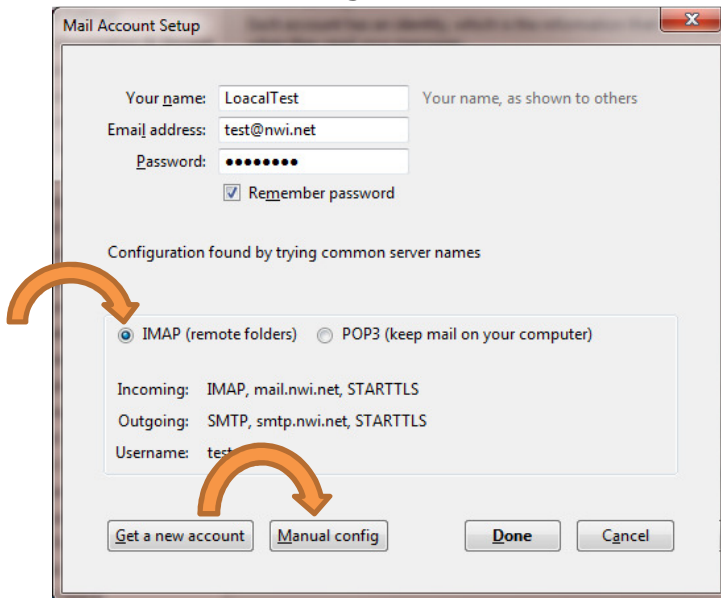
Click on Add Mail Account



Add your name, Email address and password
Check the box next to remember password and click on continue



After Thunderbird searches for your email settings Select IMAP
Click Manual Config



Enter the server hostname *mail.nwi.net* in the field next to Incoming
Set port to 143

Enter the server hostname *smtp.nwi.net* in the field next to Outgoing
Set port to 587

Set SSL to none on both servers

Authentication should be set to Normal Password for both servers

Enter your full email address as your username and click Done
